APEC ENGINEER REGISTERS

The objective of the APEC Engineer Registers is to facilitate practice by professional engineers by establishing a system of mutual recognition based on confidence in the integrity of the systems of assessment for professional practice within each economy, secured through continuing mutual monitoring, evaluation and verification of those systems.

The APEC Engineer Monitoring Committee of Japan is authorized by the APEC Engineers Agreement General Meeting (formerly the APEC Engineer Coordinating Committee) to register as APEC Engineers those applicants assessed by the processes stated in, and meeting the criteria of, *The APEC Engineer Manual*, November 2000.

Engineers on the Japan APEC Engineer Register are not exempted from any licensing or registration requirements of a host economy, and recognition privileges must be obtained by direct application to the authority concerned in the host economy. APEC Engineers may be eligible for exemptions, or partial exemptions, from additional assessments by a host economy according to mutual exemption agreements made and in force between Japan and other economies with an authorized APEC Engineer Register.
